BIOPSY REPORT

MACROSCOPIC FINDINGS : Received formalin fixed tissue measuring 1 × 1 cm, greyish white in color, firm in consistency sent for processing.

MICROSCOPIC FINDINGS : The given tissue is stained with H and E stain shows thin stretched stratified squamous epithelium of variable thickness, the underlying connective tissue is dense with collagen fibres arranged as bundles, also shows few muscles, fat cells etc.

IMPRESSION : Correlating with clinical features, the above mentioned histological features are suggestive of 'FIBROMA'.
